"A veteran came to us for assistance after the VA denied his claim for Parkinson's disease based on Agent Orange exposure...

The VA denied his claim for Parkinson's disease based on their determination that there was no evidence in the Veteran's service records that the Veteran was in Vietnam during the presumptive period...

Attorney Bridget Drop knew that finding evidence that showed the Veteran was in Vietnam was crucial to winning his case and getting the VA to grant his claim for service connected compensation...

The VA granted service connection for the Veteran's claim of coronary artery disease based on Agent Orange exposure at 60%. Under the special effective date rules as a result of the *Nehmer v. U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs* class-action lawsuit, the effective date went back to August 2010..."

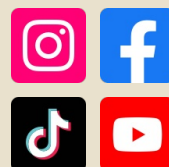


DLG Volunteer Event!
